

Starting out in the historic town of Seneca Falls, take in the history of human rights in this quaint village. Head south through the country of Seneca County, and find yourself surrounded by rich farm land. Heading west towards Seneca Lake then north to Seneca Lake State Park, stop at Rose Hill Mansion before heading into Waterloo, the Birthplace of Memorial Day to visit the historical museums, and learn more about our country's past. Parallel the Cayuga-Seneca Canal back to Seneca Falls. This ride offers an easy to moderate ride through the country side and a look into some of our country's most prominent history.


Various eateries in Downtown Seneca Falls The Crow's Nest

Turn right onto Rt. 414/Ovid St. heading South Turn Right onto Rt. 336 heading West Turn right onto Rt. 96A heading North Ventosa Vineyards will be on your left, overlooking Seneca Lake

When leaving: Turn left onto Rt. 96A heading north Turn Left onto Rts. 5 & 20 Seneca Lake State Park will be on your left

When leaving: Turn Right out of Seneca Lake State Park onto Rts. 5&20 Follow through Waterloo back to Seneca Falls
