

Turn left out of Chamber of Commerce parking lot Turn right onto Lakeville Rd. /Rt. 20A (1.4)

Turn right on Main Street, Continue through Main St.

Main veers right and becomes Avon Rd. (Rt. 39E) (3.0) Turn right onto Country Club Rd. (4.0)

Turn right onto Lima Rd. (4.5)

Turn left onto Volunteer Rd. (5.5)

Turn right onto Rt. 20A (5.9)

Turn right onto Millennium Dr. then right into
