
Start at the Cohocton River Public Fishing Access parking lot

Turn Right out of parking lot onto Rt. 415.

Turn Right onto Rt. 105 (.1)

There is a pull off lot at (1.3) overlooking the river. This is a safe and scenic spot to take a break or have a picnic. Rt. 105 leads into the village of Avoca.

At second Stop Sign turn Right onto Rt. 415 North (4.0) After crossing railroad tracks turn Right into Cohocton River Public Access parking lot (7.3)
